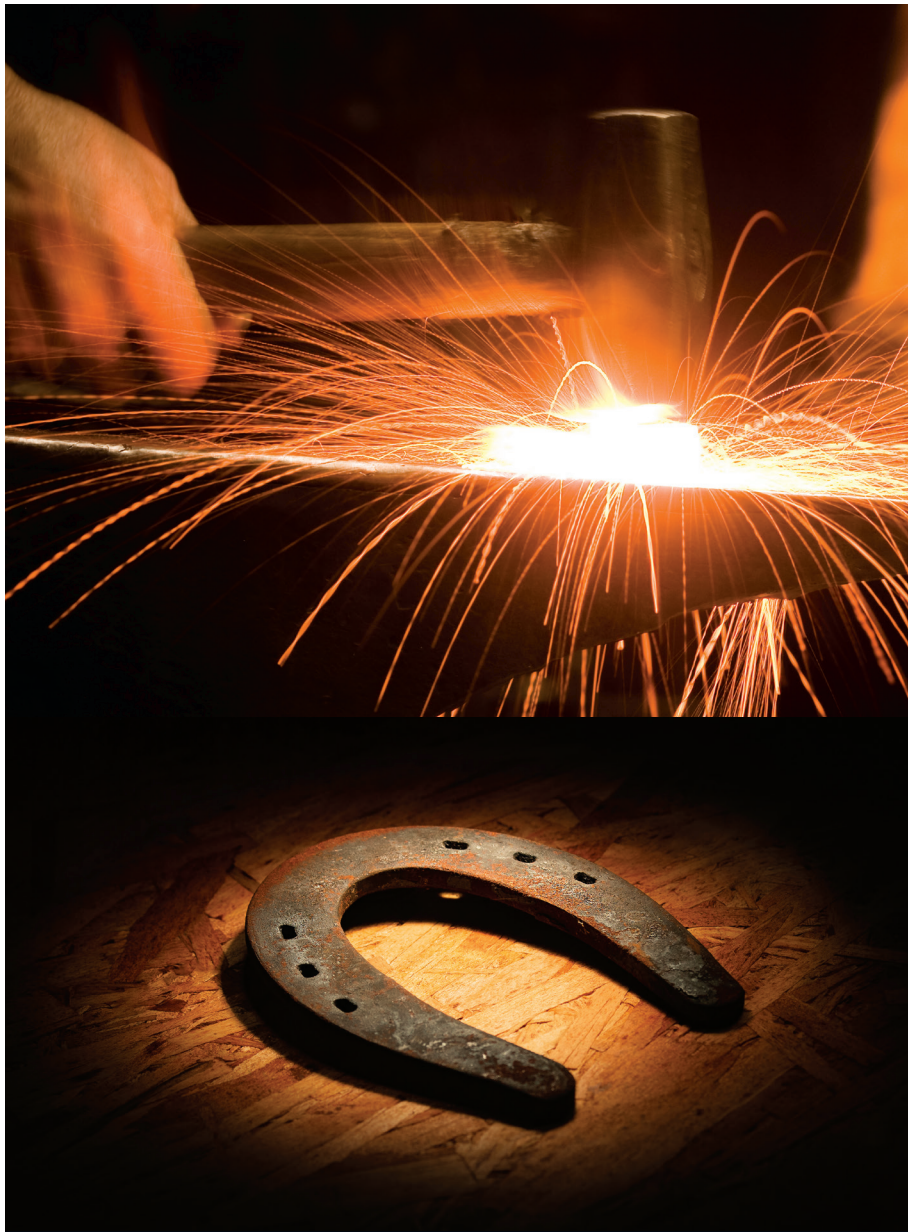

Dear USEF Participant,

USEF thanks you for participating in this competition and your support of USEF's continuous efforts to provide the safest environment possible for our athletes and other participants. Strategies for safeguarding athletes continue to evolve and we are fully committed to keeping pace with best practices.

The purpose of this letter is to remind you that you are bound by the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies, also known as the MAAPP. This includes the SafeSport Training requirement for adult members and participants who have regular contact with minor athletes. Additionally, please be reminded about reporting obligations. Any concerns that are non-sexual in nature, please use the USEF Safe Sport Incident Reporting Form available on the USEF website. Concerns or suspicions regarding sexual misconduct must be reported to <https://safesport.i-sight.com/portal> and the authorities if a minor is involved.

All of this information can be found in the USEF Safe Sport Policy. Please take a moment to review the new USEF Safe Sport web pages on the USEF website to find comprehensive resources regarding USEF Safe Sport efforts. You can also contact Sarah Gilbert, USEF Safe Sport Program Coordinator at sgilbert@usef.org for any questions or concerns relating to the USEF Safe Sport program. Thank you for your support and for helping us bring the joy of horse sports to as many people as possible!

SAFESPORT REMINDER

All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above, Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage Competitions, Endurance Rides and Vaulting Competitions: (See GR828.4 of the Federation rules). Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) lead line; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above-described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of GSWEC Horse Shows (Competition). I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable – casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4. BY SIGNING BELOW, I AGREE that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation By-laws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time, as well as all terms and provisions of this Prize List. If I am signing and submitting this Agreement electronically, I acknowledge that my electronic signature shall have the same validity, force and effect as if I affixed my signature by my own hand.

THJA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

THJA members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at competitions recognized by THJA. A person/horse may register with the THJA at a recognized horse show as long as the application(s) and payment accompany the official horse show results. Registrations may also be completed online with a credit card at the THJA website before the end of the show. All riders and trainers, in addition to owners of the THJA registered horses must be members of the THJA for the points to count. Recognition – The Fiesta Classic is operated in accordance with the current rules of the THJA by which they are recognized and rated A in Perf. 3'6" & 3'3", Green 3', 3'3", 3'6" & 3'9", A/O 3'6" & 3'9", Junior 3'6" & 3'9", Pony, Green Pony, Children's, Adult, Modified Adult and Children's, Short/Long Stirrup, Jr/AO, Children's and Adult Jumpers. Points for placing in Junior, Children's, Pony and Adult Eq., Hunter Breeding, Opportunity W/T and Opportunity Cross Rails hunters will be credited in accordance with THJA rules.

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and GSWEC Horse Shows - Katy, TX ("USEF Event" or "USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("Risks").

WARNING:

UNDER TEXAS LAW (CHAPTER 87, CIVIL PRACTICE AND REMEDIES CODE), A FARM ANIMAL PROFESSIONAL IS NOT LIABLE FOR AN INJURY TO OR THE DEATH OF A PARTICIPANT IN FARM ANIMAL ACTIVITIES RESULTING FROM THE INHERENT RISKS OF FARM ANIMAL ACTIVITIES.

C. ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I understand that the aforementioned Risks may be caused in whole or in part or result directly or indirectly from the negligence of my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the USEF Events, or the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties defined below, and I hereby voluntarily and knowingly assume all such Risks and responsibility for any damages, liabilities, losses, or expenses that I incur as a result of my participation in any USEF Events. I also agree to be responsible for any injury or damage caused by me, my horse, my employees or contractors under my direction and control at any USEF Event.

D. WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNITY: In conjunction with my participation in any USEF Event, I hereby release, waive and covenant not to sue, and further agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the following parties: USEF, USEF Recognized Affiliate Associations, the United States Olympic & Paralympic Committee (USOPC), USEF clubs, members, Event participants (including athletes/riders, coaches, trainers, judges/officials, and other personnel), the Event owner, licensee, and competition managers; the promoters, sponsors, or advertisers of any USEF Event; any charity or other beneficiary which may benefit from the USEF Event; the owners, managers, or lessors of any facilities or premises where a USEF Event may be held; and all directors, officers, employees, agents, contractors, and volunteers of any of the aforementioned parties (**Individually and Collectively, the "Released Parties" or "Event Organizers"**), with respect to any liability, claim(s), demand(s), cause(s) of action, damage(s), loss, or expense (including court costs and reasonable attorney fees) of any kind or nature ("**Liability**") which may arise out of, result from, or relate in any way to my participation in the USEF Events, including claims for Liability caused in whole or in part by the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties.

E. COMPLETE AGREEMENT AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: This Agreement represents the complete understanding between the parties regarding these issues and no oral representations, statements or inducements have been made apart from this Agreement. If any provision of this Agreement is held to be unlawful, void, or for any reason unenforceable, then that provision shall be deemed severable from this Agreement and shall not affect the validity and enforceability of any remaining provisions.

Enter online at www.horshowsonline.com. Every entry blank must have the adult signature of the owner/authorized agent, trainer and riders and be accompanied by an open check or valid credit card info. **NO NUMBERS WILL BE ISSUED WITH OUT VALID FORM OF PAYMENT.** There will be a \$75 office/services fee for every horse on the show grounds. Management reserves the right to refuse any entry for any reason. Horses on the grounds, not entered in any classes must still have a completed entry blank on file in the office and will be charged a \$100 non-showing fee per week. Horses not accruing a minimum of \$100 in entry fees may be charged the non-showing fee in addition to entry fees. **WARNING:** horses/riders that compete in a class in which they are not properly entered will be charged a double entry fee. Foreign exhibitors: All fees must be paid in "US Funds". **In order to ensure correct number of horse and tack stalls, number of shavings and any feed or hay orders, please fill out the STALL RESERVATION FORM on GSWEC.com**

HORSE REGISTRATION / MEASUREMENTS / MEMBERSHIP CREDENTIALS

- All horses and ponies competing in USEF licensed Hunter and Jumper shows, except those entered exclusively in Opportunity and/or Walk Trot classes must be registered at USHJA.ORG. The animal's registration number must be provided. To be eligible for national, regional or zone HOTY awards, animals must have a yearly or lifetime recording number provided by registering at USEF.ORG.
- Animals competing exclusively in Opportunity and/or Walk Trot classes do not need registration.
- All animals entered in classes restricted to ponies or Small Junior Hunter classes must have been officially measured at a licensed competition and be in possession of a valid measurement card. Animals that need to be measured to compete must set up a measurement session with the show office and USEF steward. Measurement times and location will be provided when scheduled.
- All persons listed on entry blanks as Owners, Trainers, Riders, and Coaches as well as any adult signing as agent or guardian for other entities must be a current USEF member or, must obtain a ONE-TIME-ONLY show pass for the current competition. The show pass must be applied for and paid for at USEF.ORG.
- All persons listed on entry blanks must also be current members of USHJA or will be charged a show pass fee of \$30 each show/week on your competition invoice. Please join at USHJA.ORG to avoid fees.
- Only persons competing exclusively in Opportunity and/or Walk Trot classes are exempt from show pass fees. Once entered into non-Opportunity or non-Walk trot classes, show pass rules will apply.
- Any adult person riding in classes restricted to Amateurs must be in possession of USEF issued Amateur certification. This certification must accompany a current USEF membership by signing as an Amateur at the time of joining.

CLOSING DATE

Entries are due by October 23, 2024. Post entries and entries for new or different horses made after that date will incur the one-time late fee of \$75.00.

SHOW OFFICE

The show office will be open one day before the competition starts and each competition day will open 1 hour before the earliest start time for rings.

COMPETITION NUMBERS

OFFICE ISSUED NUMBERS must be worn in all competition rings

ADDS / SCRATCHES

All adds must be completed online at www.HorseShowsOnline.com or at in the show office no later than 4:00pm the day prior to the class. Time permitting, same day adds will be accepted at the ingate and will be put on a wait list of each show ring. Scratches will be accepted at any time prior to the start of the class – Scratch fees may apply. Any scratches in the Derby after 4:00pm the night prior to the class will incur a \$100 scratch fee.

TRAINER ACCOUNT SPLITS

The horse show offers a service that allows trainers to purchase shavings, feed, tack stalls etc. directly from the horse show and then split those charges onto customer's accounts. Trainer splits will be accepted until noon Friday with no exceptions made after that time. Please be reminded that this is a complimentary service provided by the horse show and that doing splits in a timely manner is their responsibility. Also, any splits uncollected from the client will revert back to the trainer for payment.

SETTLEMENT OF ACCOUNTS

All show accounts must be closed out at the end of each week. Any open entry accounts will be closed by management and a \$60 processing fee will be added to that entry. All questions about accounts must be addressed within 48 hours of the conclusion of the show. Any mistakes or questions regarding your account and/or prize money must be resolved within that 48-hour time frame.

REFUNDS

Pre-paid stall fees will not be refunded after the entry close date. Entry fees will be refunded with a certificate of illness or injury prepared by an accredited veterinarian, or a doctor's note regarding a rider's illness/injury. The office/processing fee will still apply to all scratched horses after the entry close date. Any unprocessed prize money or refund checks outstanding six months after issuance date will be forfeited.

NON-NEGOTIABLE CHECKS

A \$50.00 service fee or 10% of the check amount plus expenses incurred to collect fees - whichever is greater will be charged for all returned checks. Credit card payments that are "charged back" will also incur the same fees and possibly end up preventing the acceptance of future entries.

CREDIT CARD FEE

A convenience fee of 3% of the total invoice will be added to all accounts closed with a credit or debit card.

USEF / USHJA FEES

Current USEF rules relating to the drug and medication program will be enforced. Each horse entered must pay the \$15.00 Drug & Medication fee plus the \$8.00 Federation fee. All entries will also be required to pay the \$7.00 USHJA fee. Total fees for the two associations will be \$30.00.

JUMPER NOMINATION FEE

Horses competing in all 1.25 Meter classes, and above, must pay a nominating fee of \$150, unless otherwise stated.

RINGSIDE AMENITIES FEE

This \$50.00 fee includes the cost of video playback and display monitors for ringside instant replay as well as live streaming when available. Videos can be viewed at www.JKVideo.co. All rings are equipped with an outdoor monitor to view an instant replay of your completed round. All rounds can be watched the week of the show. Video downloads are subjected to additional fees. The \$50.00 fee is limited to 2 charges per owner/lessee per show.

NIGHT WATCH FEE

All horses occupying a stall, whether showing or non-showing will be required to pay the night watch fee of \$25.00. Horses will be checked each night of the show week every two hours. This service is not optional, per current USEF rule HJ107i.

CAMPERS

Camper spaces are available for \$300 per week in spaces 34-96. The Premier camper spaces are available for \$325 per Week in spaces 1-30. One complimentary pump out (Sat. morning) is included in the weekly fee.

STABLING

Permanent and temporary stabling will be available at a cost of \$325 per week. Ship-ins will be charged a \$125 grounds/clean up fee per horse per day. Stalls will be available for move in at 10:00am on Nov 6th unless prior arrangements have been made. 12x12 and 10x10 permanent stalls with doors and mats are available. Portable stalls do not have mats. Stalls must be returned to GSEC in the same condition upon move out. All nails, hooks and the like must be removed from stalls upon move out. No sharing of stalls is allowed. All stall reservations must be made with the Stabling manager. Stalls can NOT be re-sold without the Stable Manager's approval. Each horse will be charged either a stall fee or a daily grounds fee. Shavings and feed are available for purchase on the show grounds between 7:00am and 5:00pm. No outside shavings are permitted. Violators will be charged \$100 per stall. Once shavings are delivered, there are **NO RETURNS**.

GARBAGE DISPOSAL

All trash must be disposed of in proper receptacles. No garbage is to be dumped in the manure bins. Violators will be charged a \$500 fine.

SHARPS DISPOSAL

Sharps containers will be provided in all barns for the disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments. All items of this nature **MUST BE DISPOSED OF IN THE PROVIDED CONTAINERS. NONE ARE TO BE DISPOSED OF IN ANY RECEPTACLE OTHER THAN THE PROVIDED SHARPS CONTAINER.** Any individual or entity not in compliance will be subject to a \$100.00 fine per USEF rule GR1210.4c.

USEF VACCINATION RULE

USEF rule GR844 is the Equine Vaccination Rule. Horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus vaccination within 6 months prior to entering the grounds. Without proper documentation, horses will not be allowed to enter show grounds.

HEALTH CERTIFICATES / COGGINS TESTS

A health certificate dated within 21 days of arrival is to be presented when entering the show grounds. CVI must state that each horse has not been treated for an elevated temperature or anything related to herd health in the last 21 days. Texas law requires that each horse be accompanied by a negative EIA (Coggins) test certificate dated within 1 year. A **printed** packet of your horse health papers must be dropped off at the check-in location prior to entering the Great Southwest Equestrian Center. Horses without these certifications and paperwork will not be permitted on the show grounds.

RINGS AND FOOTING

The outside ESI ring is approximately 140' x 275' with ESI all-weather footing. Mega Rings are approximately 145' x 265' also with ESI footing. The Tellepsen Indoor Arena is approx. 150' x 250' with sandy loam footing. The Main Indoor Arena is 150' x 300' with ESI footing. The Wheless Arena is 125' x 250' with sandy loam footing. The Sand ring is 130' x 290' with all-weather footing. As properly maintained footing is a priority, rings may be closed to schooling during inclement weather and/or for maintenance at any time during the show at the manager's discretion.

WARM-UP AND LUNGING AREAS

Main jumper warm-up ring is 175' x 90' with ESI footing. West warm-up ring is 120' by 60' with ESI footing. Arena 1 warm-up ring is 130' x 265' with sandy loam footing. Otto warm-up ring is 125' x 275' with Otto Sport Footing. Wheless warm-up ring is 120' x 150' with sandy loam footing. South warm up ring is 150' x 275' with all weather footing.

SCHOOLING

Hunter rings will be open for schooling on the day prior to the show. Time and weather permitting, rings may also be open before and after the show each day. Schooling times will be posted or announced. No manual poling and no offset oxers of any type may be used while schooling. Jumping will be permitted in the rings at scheduled times and only when medical personnel are on the grounds.

ATTIRE AND HEADGEAR

All riders must be properly attired. Consult the USEF rulebook for details on attire. Protective head gear must be worn by all riders, at all times while mounted anywhere and anytime on the show grounds. Headgear for all riders must meet or exceed ASTM Standards and must carry the SEI tag. All headgear must be properly secured by its harness. If unsure that your helmet is properly secured or properly approved, please check with the USEF steward.

JUMP ORDERS

Show management may determine a rotating jump order for all classes over fences. Riders or trainers with conflicts must see the paddock masters in each involved ring so that the necessary adjustments can be made.

COURSES AND JOGGING

Courses will be posted a minimum of one hour prior to each class. At management's discretion, a dotted line may be put into effect to restrict the size of courtesy circles in hunter classes. Jogging for soundness in hunter classes that require it will be completed by trotting a circle in front of the judge at the completion of each over fences round.

TIES IN JUMPER SECTIONS

Ties for all jumper classes will jump off for first place only. Ties for all other places will be determined by first round times. Championships will be determined using the 10,6,4,2,1,.5 point system. Bonus points will apply to the class indicated for each section.

CHANGES / CANCELATIONS / COMBINING OF SECTIONS

Management reserves the right to change, cancel or combine classes and/or sections, alter courses and do all things necessary to comply with USEF rules and to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries.

RIBBONS / TROPHIES / CHAMPIONSHIPS / PRIZE MONEY

All hunter classes will receive a trophy and 8 ribbons unless otherwise noted. Jumper and Equitation classes will receive a trophy and six ribbons unless otherwise noted. Each hunter, jumper and equitation section with 3 or more classes will receive a championship and reserve championship for horses or riders accumulating the highest number of points in the section. In hunter sections, under saddle points will only be considered for the top 4 points-winning horses over fences. Green Conformation Model class points will be counted as ½ points. All ribbons and prizes not awarded at the ring can be picked up in the designated Ribbon and Prize room located in the offices next to the Main arena. Prize money won can be paid by check or deducted from each horse's account. An IRS W-9 form must be completed in full before any prize money can be paid. Prize money will be withheld if the recipient's Social Security or EIN number is not provided. ANIMAL WELFARE

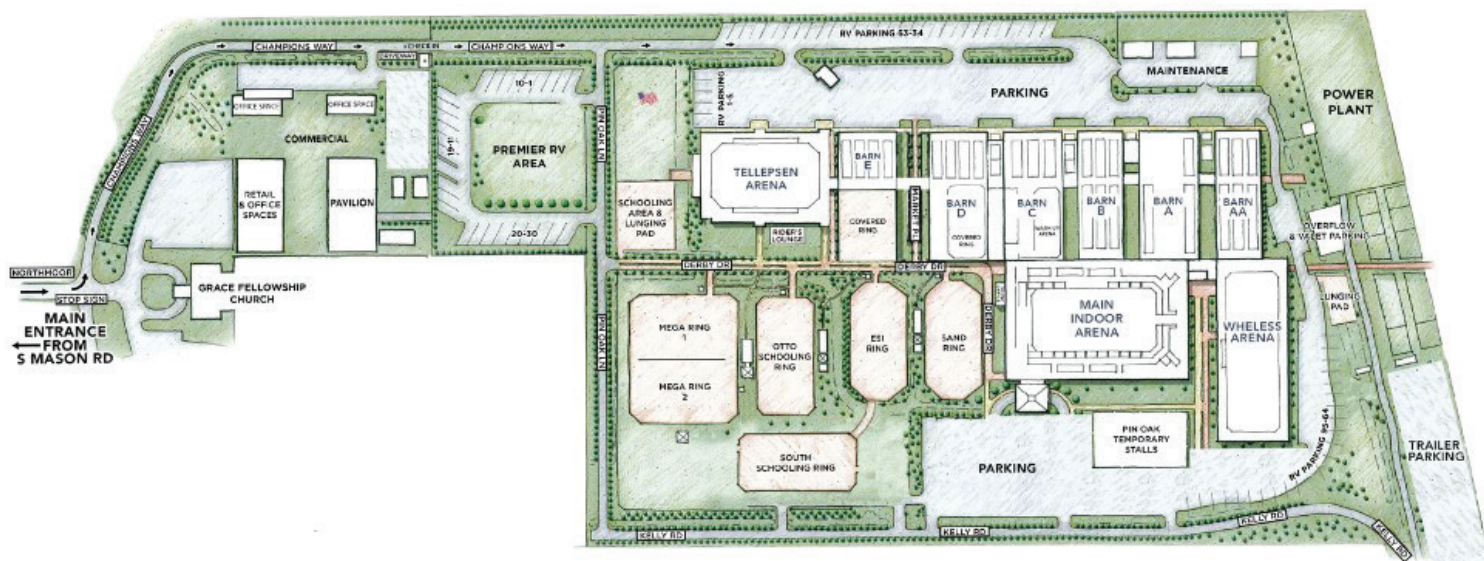

Prize monies will be withheld if the recipient's SS# is not on file.

W-9s

HUNTER DIVISIONS

Courses will simulate fences found in the hunt field such as; brush, wall, in and out, oxer, post/rails, gates, Aiken and panels. Classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted. Horses/ponies are required to trot a circle on a loose rein at the end of each over fences performance. Horses/ponies may be asked to return to the ring and trot another circle at the judge's discretion. Sections will be combined as necessary per USEF rules. 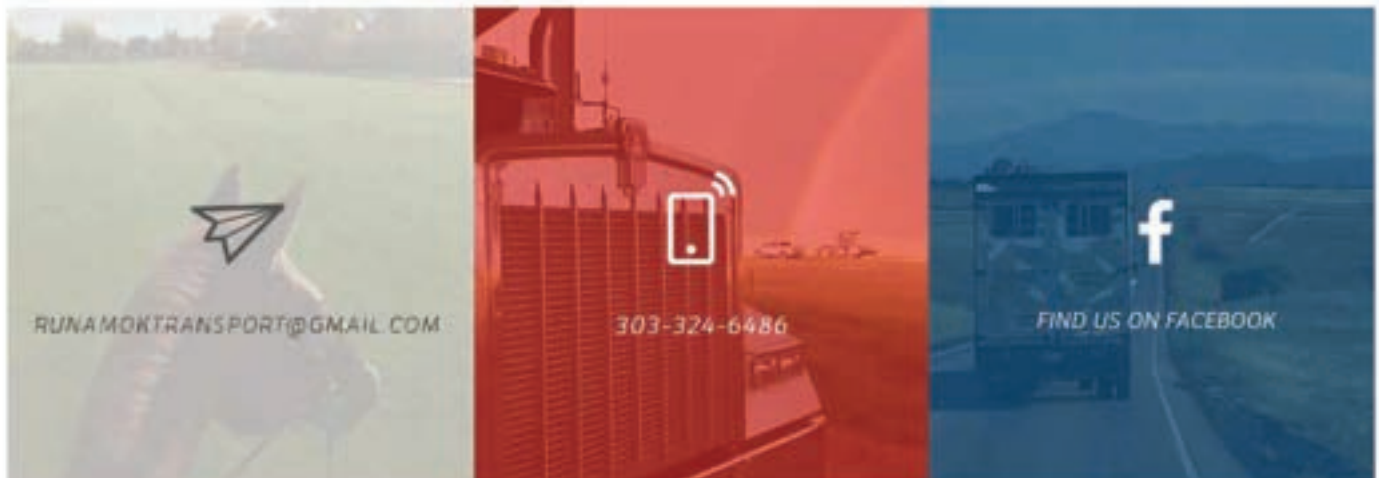
